

Supplemental File Troubleshooting

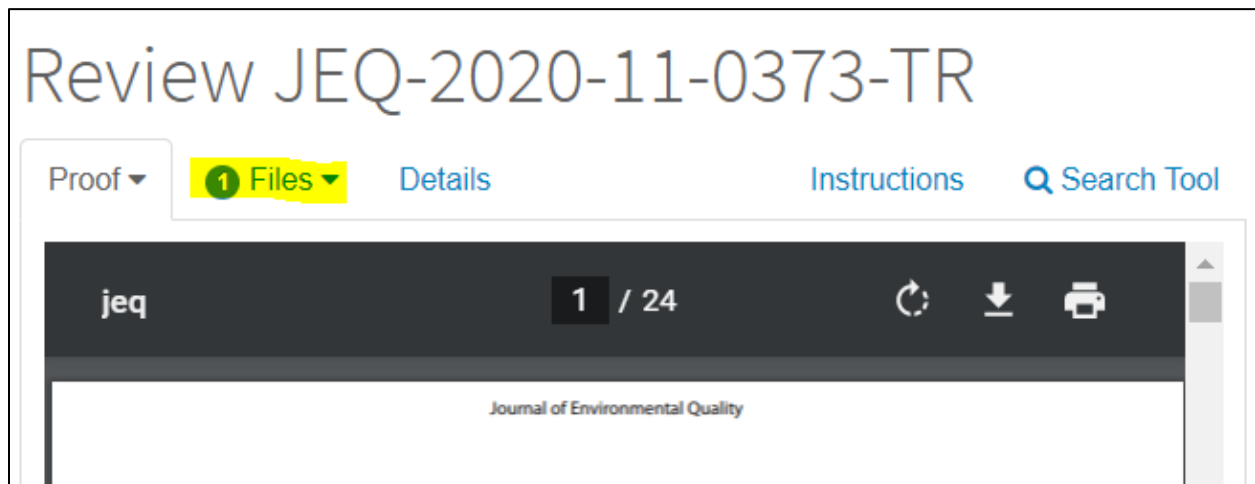
Supplemental files are files that are not included in the main text of the manuscript. They are uploaded at the file upload stage and, if the paper is accepted, may also be uploaded to Dryad (see our [Dryad](#) page for more information).

However, due to restrictions on how supplemental files can be uploaded and/or converted into the proof PDF, authors and/or reviewers can sometimes run into problems. If that happens, here are some ways to help.

For authors

If an author emails you to say that their supplemental files are not uploading or displaying properly in the PDF, please forward their message to manuscripts@sciencesocieties.org. Headquarters staff can then “uncheck” the files from the list of documents to be included in the proof PDF. They will then alert the appropriate editors to let them know that reviewers will need to review those documents outside the proof PDF by downloading the files from the “original files” dropdown in the reviewer pane.

Please note that for blinded journals, reviewers are not allowed to download the original files. The reason for this is that original documents can contain identifying information either in their titles or files properties. If a reviewer requests an original file from a blinded journal, please email manuscripts@sciencesocieties.org for assistance.



For reviewers

If a reviewer says that the files are not suitable for review, please have them download the files via the “original files” dropdown in the reviewer pane.

Please note that for blinded journals, reviewers are not allowed to download the original files. The reason for this is that original documents can contain identifying information either in their titles or files properties. If a reviewer requests an original file from a blinded journal, please email manuscripts@sciencesocieties.org for assistance.

File Type Restrictions

Please note that certain kinds of files may not be accepted as supplemental files. If an author would like to submit a file type that is not accepted, please email manuscripts@sciencesocieties.org for assistance. Please be sure to include the manuscript id and any relevant supplemental file attachments.
